The Responsible Living™ Day Treatment Program is a **State Certified Juvenile Sex Offender** program. As a State Certified treatment agency, TVN can impact the future of adolescent sex offenders by petitioning the courts to reduce and/or terminate duties to register upon satisfactory completion of TVN's sexually reactive and juvenile sex offender programs.

The program was developed by The Village Network for youth in need of intensive mental health services and academic instruction and has gained national respect as a model program for adolescent sexual offenders. It has prevented youth from entering residential programs.

Admission Criteria

- Male Youth
- Primary Ages 12 to 18-year-olds
- Non-adjudicated **or** adjudicated youth (Tier I, II, or III registrants)

Treatment Services

- Full-day, on-grounds school at Boys' Village Campus staffed by Wooster City Schools - Virtual learning program w/on-site teacher in Columbus
- Partial Hospitalization (15 hours/week) with Mental Health Group Therapy
- Individual, family and recreational therapy
- Transportation to/from program location
- Lunch provided
- Comprehensive diagnostic assessment
- Risk Assessment – ERASOR® and/or J-SOAP II®
- Psychological and/or psychiatric evaluations Aftercare and community follow-up
