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Admission Criteria

- Male and Female Youth
- Primary Ages 12 to 18-year-olds
- Non-adjudicated or adjudicated youth

Treatment Services

- Academic instruction in partnership with Coventry School District
- Additional educational resources include one-on-one tutoring, small group instruction, on-line credit recovery, educational skill development and GED preparation
- Comprehensive Diagnostic Assessment
- Individual, group, family and recreational therapy
- Psychotropic medication management
- Psychological and psychiatric evaluation
- Life skills development

The Village Network has focused on shaping productive, responsible youth for 65 years with an award-winning history of success. We operate under a *Continuum of Care* model which provides consistency and includes residential treatment, day treatment, treatment foster care, respite care and alternative school programs.
