Admission Criteria

- Male Youth
- Primary Ages 12 to 18-year-olds
- Non-adjudicated **or** adjudicated youth (Tier I, II, or III registrants)

Treatment Services

- Full-day, on-grounds school staffed by Wooster City Schools
- 24/7 year-round, staff-secured cottage facilities
- Comprehensive diagnostic assessment
- Minimum 15 hours per week of planned group treatment
- Individual, family, recreational and art therapy
- Video conferencing available for visitation, team meetings, etc.
- Life skills training
- Risk assessment and safety planning
- Psychological and/or psychiatric evaluations
- Psychotropic medication management
- Aftercare and community follow-up

Specialized Programming

- Short-term sex offender assessment and treatment
- Specialized residential programming including limited intellectual functioning and co-existing substance abuse
- Step-down options within TVN Continuum of Care including Respite, Day Treatment and Treatment Foster Care - locations available throughout Ohio

The Village Network has focused on shaping productive, responsible youth for 65 years with an award-winning history of success. We operate under a *Continuum of Care* model which provides consistency and includes residential treatment, day treatment, treatment foster care, respite care and alternative school programs. There are multiple locations across the state including Akron, Canton, Cleveland, Columbus, Delaware, Mount Vernon/Knox County, Mansfield, Lorain, Newark, Sandusky, Uhrichsville, Wooster and Youngstown.
