Referral & Program Information

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Admission Criteria

- Male and Female Youth
- Primary Ages 10 to 21-year-olds

Treatment Services

- Comprehensive diagnostic assessment, may include trauma specific and/or independent living
- Self-trauma model of emotional processing
- Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavior Therapy
- Trauma-informed Psycho-educational Group Curriculum
- Individual, family and expressive arts therapies
- Psychological and/or psychiatric evaluations
- Psychotropic medication management
- Teaching Family Model
- School-based partial hospitalization program
- Aftercare and community follow up

We operate under a *Continuum of Care* model which provides consistency and includes residential treatment, day treatment, treatment foster care, respite care and alternative school programs.
