### Mount Vernon/Knox County

The Transitional Living Program available at the Mount Vernon/Knox County location is open to both male and female youth. It is a safe, secure living arrangement where older youth (16 to 21 years-old) prepare to live independently as adults while under program supervision and guidance. The program teaches tangible skills and real-life application of those every day skills. This program can serve as a step-down from residential, treatment foster care, or an alternative safe environment.
