### Admission Criteria

- Male Youth (non-sex offender)
- Primary Ages 12 to 18-years-old

### Short Term Behavioral Treatment Services

- Full-day, on-grounds school staffed by Wooster City Schools
- 24/7 year-round, staff-secured cottage facilities
- Comprehensive Diagnostic Assessment
- Substance Abuse assessment, education, and treatment
- 18 hours weekly of planned therapeutic services on social responsibility
- Individual, family, recreational and expressive arts therapy
- Life skills training
- Risk assessment and safety planning
- Psychological and/or psychiatric evaluations
- Psychotropic medication management
- Aftercare and community follow-up

The Village Network has focused on shaping productive, responsible youth for over 60 years with an award-winning history of success. We operate under a Continuum of Care model which provides consistency and includes residential treatment, day treatment, treatment foster care, respite care and alternative school programs. There are 10 locations across the state including Akron, Canton, Cleveland, Columbus, Delaware, Knox County/Mt. Vernon, Lorain, Newark, Uhrichsville and Wooster.
